



Stowe boasts one of the largest, most diverse Nordic trail systems in the United States. Four inter-connected cross-country ski centers and over 3000 acres of conserved land provide 150 km of groomed trails and 100 km of backcountry terrain. High elevations and shelter from sun and wind award Stowe with a lengthy season and superb snow.

From perfectly groomed tracks to smooth, wide skating lanes to fine, untracked backcountry skiing – Stowe has trails for people and families of every ability. This Nordic treasure surrounds Stowe's historic village, outstanding lodges, quality restaurants and unique shops – many accessible right from the trails.

Whether you are a seasoned cross-country skier looking for adventure, or this is your first time seeing snow and you want a gentle outdoor winter experience – put on a pair of skis and enjoy!

Stowe Recreation Path

This award-winning multi-use path is a favorite for locals and visitors, and is groomed in the winter months for easy and free cross-country skiing! The path begins in the village, and follows the West Branch River through wooded areas and meadows.
